Designing and Developing Responsible Organisations

The financial crisis showed that only focusing on economic profit is problematic: We need sustainable solutions that also address 'people' and 'planet'. How can organisations contribute to such long-term values? Through cases and recent research you will gain insight in different approaches how to design meaningful work and how to collaborate with various stakeholders.

The course draws on insights from recent research as well as on classical approaches such as socio- technical systems theory for which Radboud University has a long-standing track record.

Content

- The role and responsibility of organisations in society
- Principles of organisation design and socio-technical systems theory
- Designing decentralised, networked organisations with examples and case study from healthcare
- · Designing for wellbeing at work
- Ethical questions and the dark side of organisations
- Initiating change towards sustainability: how do you convince others of the operational relevance of something so abstract and distant as the future of humanity and the planet?
- Orchestrating collaborations with diverse partners across the value network

After this course you are able to:

- Identify how the structure and social practices in an organisation contribute to social and ecological footprint
- Pitch your ideas for sustainability to different audiences
- Analyse an organisation's position in its value network and develop approaches for sustainable collaboration processes across networks
- Devise interventions to improve the social and ecological footprint
