In order to promote US-China cooperation and understanding, the 21st Century China Program at the University of California, San Diego has launched a collaborative research initiative examining Chinese politics, economy and society. We invite scholars from Chinese academic and research institutions to submit proposals on specific topics and join the 21st Century China Program scholars in research collaboration.

The 21st Century China Program at the University of California, San Diego is a leading research and educational center that uses original research to promote China and China-US policy discussions. The Program has a strong research team, and it particularly values empirical and policy-relevant studies of China. We will select six researchers in the following areas. Selected researcher will be designated as the "Program Fellow." They will receive financial support from the Program so they can be in residence at UC San Diego for up to six months in total between 2014 and 2016. The project is set to begin in summer 2014 and last through summer 2016. Interested researchers need to submit a concrete topic from one of the areas below:

- 3. 有实证调查与研究经验,在相关课题领域发 表过或正在撰写有关文章
- 4. 具备较好的英语阅读与写作能力

Interested researchers must meet the following qualifications:

- 1. Must be affiliated with a Chinese academic or research institution. Junior researchers, including Ph.D candidates, postdoctoral fellows and assistant professors are preferred.
- 2. Strong background in social science research methodology.
- 3. Prior experience with field research on related topics or publication in related journals.
- 4. Strong English language (reading and writing) ability.
