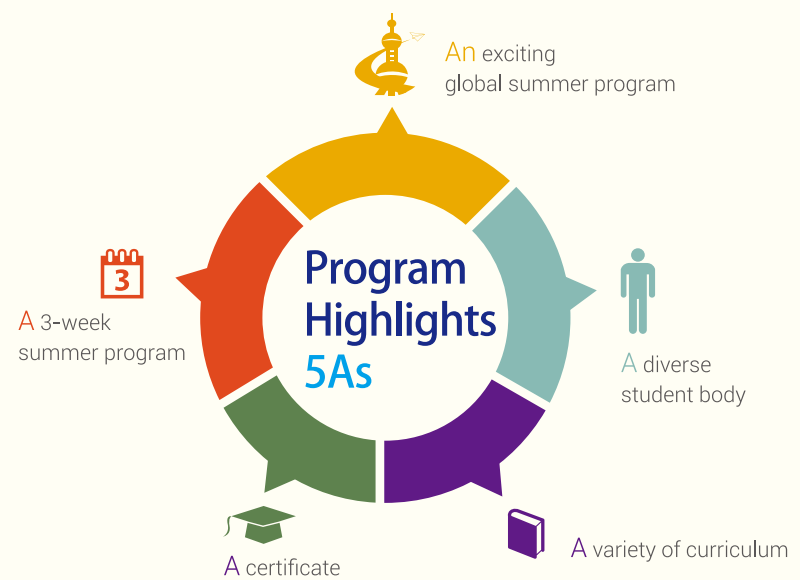

- A certificate from Shanghai Jiao Tong University and 3 SJTU academic credits upon successful completion of the program.

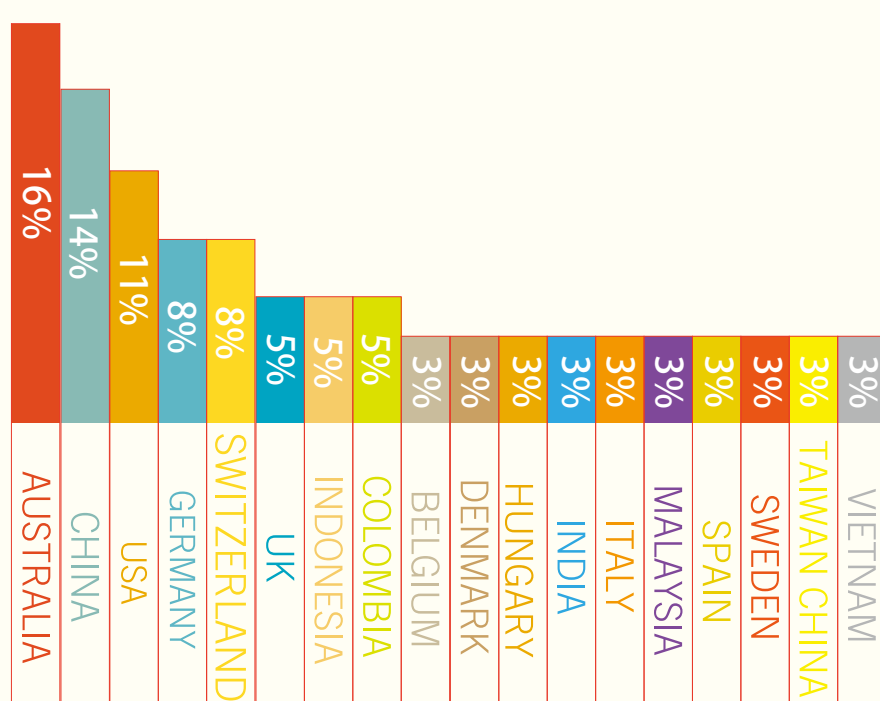


PARTICIPANT PROFILE

APPLICATION INFORMATION

Who should apply?

- Open to undergraduate and master students from around the world.
- Recent college graduates or professionals who are interested in learning Chinese culture and business dynamics in China are also welcome to apply.
- Participants are required to be adults aged at or above 18.

How to apply?

- The following documents are required for application:
- Submit completed application form
 - Curriculum Vitae, including educational and professional experience
 - Official transcript from home institution (scanned file acceptable)
 - Valid passport (copy file)
 - ID photograph (image file)
 - Application fee of USD80

When to apply?

Rolling admission starts in November 1, 2013. Interested candidates are required to submit complete application materials before deadline of May 16, 2014.
